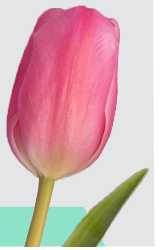

THE HISTORY OF THE WHITE HOUSE EASTER EGG ROLL

What could be simpler or more fun than a silly event featuring grown men in bunny suits? One of the most popular ways to celebrate Easter in the United States has always been hunting for Easter eggs, with the biggest event being the Easter egg roll at the White House. But this joyful event has a contentious past, all because of some Easter grinch. Party at the White House The White House was finished in 1800, and the third president to live within its walls was James Madison, whose wife, Dolley Todd Madison, was famous for her ability to use social functions as a way to foster bipartisan cooperation. Prior to her exemplary hosting, the president would only meet with members of one party at a time, which

resulted in distrust, scheming, and often actual physical violence. But with Dolley at the forefront of creating welcoming events where politicians could socialize amicably and outside of a high-pressure political meeting, progress was more easily made. One event that she started was the White House Egg Roll, inviting hundreds of children to bring their eggs and play games on the White House lawn in 1814. Egg rolls had been informally popular for many years, with stories of such parties happening under Abraham Lincoln's administration as well. As the years progressed, the event became more and more popular, with Washingtonians from all socioeconomic levels gathering for the fun event. By the 1870s, the Capitol Building and its expansive lawn was the most popular place to host the egg roll, although smaller events were held all over the city, including the White House lawn.
