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WELCOME JUNE! FLAG DAY!

FLAG ETIQUETTE DOS:

Display from sunrise to sunset:

Unless illuminated, the flag should be displayed only during daylight hours.

Maintain the flag's appearance:

Ensure the flag is clean, well-maintained, and not torn or damaged.

Display with other flags:

When displayed with other flags, the American flag should be the highest and centered.

Properly position the flag:

When displayed against a wall, the union (stars) should be in the upper left-hand corner (the flag's own right).

Respect the flag's placement:

The flag should not be allowed to touch the ground or be displayed upside down (except as a signal of distress).

Use the flag appropriately:

Do not use the flag as clothing, decoration, or for commercial purposes.

Handle with care:

The flag should be folded and stored properly, and never displayed in a way that can cause damage.

Understand and follow official guidelines:

The US Flag Code, found on the American Legion website and other government sources, provides detailed guidance on flag etiquette

FLAG ETIQUETTE DON'TS:

- Don't dip the U.S. flag for any person, flag, or vessel.
- Don't let the U.S. flag touch the ground.
- Don't fly the flag upside down unless there is an emergency.
- Don't carry the U.S. flag flat, or carry things in it.
- Don't use the U.S. flag as clothing.
- Don't store the U.S. flag where it can get dirty.
- Don't use it as a cover.
- Don't fasten it or tie it back. Always allow it to fall free.
- Don't draw on or otherwise mark the U.S. flag.
- Don't use the U.S. flag for decoration. Use bunting with the blue on top, then white, then red.

JUNETEENTH

Juneteenth, also known as Juneteenth National Independence Day, is a United States federal holiday that commemorates the emancipation of enslaved African Americans in Galveston, Texas, on June 19, 1865. This date marks the end of slavery in the country and is considered by many as a second Independence Day.

HERE’S A MORE DETAILED LOOK AT JUNETEENTH:

Origin:

On June 19, 1865, Union General Gordon Granger arrived in Galveston, Texas, and announced that the Emancipation Proclamation had been enacted, officially freeing enslaved people in the state.

Delayed Emancipation:

It’s important to note that this news was delayed in reaching Texas, as the Civil War had ended two months prior, and the Emancipation Proclamation had been issued in 1863.

Celebration and Tradition:

Juneteenth is celebrated with various traditions, including public readings of the Emancipation Proclamation, singing traditional songs, and reading works by African-American writers like Maya Angelou.

Significance:

Juneteenth is a reminder of the long struggle for freedom and equality for Black Americans and a time to reflect on the ongoing fight for social justice. It also provides a platform for open dialogue about the country’s history of slavery and racial injustice.

National Recognition:

Juneteenth became a federal holiday in 2021, making it the first new federal holiday since Martin Luther King Jr. Day.
