TIPS FOR STAYING HEALTHY **DURING FLU SEASON!**

On October 7th, nursing will be rolling out our flu and covid vaccines for our second-floor residents. Vaccines for staff and first floor will occur soon after. In a facility where we are all in close proximity with many medically sensitive people, it's important we all take precautions to minimize the spread of illness, especially during cold and flu season. Veronica, our infection control nurse, advises everyone at Centre to wash their hands before meals and after encountering animals and other people. When washing hands is not immediately available, use hand sanitizer. If you develop any symptoms of illness, like an abnormal cough or sore throat, let a staff member know as soon as possible and limit your contact with others when possible.

We also asked a group of our residents what they do to stay healthy. Here are some of their suggestions:

• Many residents voiced that they exercise on a regular basis, either with activities or independently

- Jan wears a mask when around others, especially when there's an outbreak in the facility
- Dot keeps lots of live plants in her room to keep the air clean
- Nancy H. enjoys fresh fruit, especially citrus, to boost her immunity
- Dot also uses lotion that has Vitamin C in it *It should be noted that while topical application of* Vitamin C can boost collagen in the skin, it does not directly correlate with boosting the immune system unless ingested.
- Jan suggested taking both Vitamin C and Zinc as supplements
