**A Royal Wedding Started It All**  
Now billed as the largest volksfest, or "people's fair," in the world, the first Oktoberfest was held on October 12, 1810, in honor of the wedding of Crown Prince Ludwig (later King Ludwig I) and Princess Therese of Saxe- Hildburghausen. The happy couple wanted to share

their joy with all of Munich, so they invited the entire city to join in the festivities held in the fields in front of the city gates. A parade led to feasting, music, and dancing that went on for several days.

Horse races attended by the royal family ended the celebration. When it was later decided to make the horse races an annual event, the tradition of Oktoberfest was born.
