Mark has worked as a historical interpreter for the Friends of Gettysburg (PA), the National Park Service at Fort Laramie, WY, and at Centennial Village over in Greeley. Mark also worked on several museum projects for the Colorado State Historical Society and while with them, served as assistant museum director at the Trinidad History Museum. After the devastating floods of 2013, he was hired as a historic preservationist with FEMA and after that campaign concluded, continued in historic preservation with Pinyon Environmental Inc. in Lakewood.”
